Year-Round Course

PSC 5960, Introduction to Public Administration

Students must register by May 16, 2004 for Summer Semester and complete the work by August 1, 2004.

Students are required to answer eight questions over the book, *Public Administration in America*. The list of questions will be given at time of registration. Each answer should be about 600-800 words and should be typewritten and double-spaced. Answers will be graded on content and critiqued on the quality of the essay.
